# **Core Programs**

#### LOOK: A Film/Mental Health Initiative

The LOOK Program is a 6-month long mental health, film initiative. This pioneering vocational film education program empowers individuals with mental health challenges to express themselves creatively through filmmaking, supported by mental health practitioners and members of the film and teaching community. LOOK is strategically partnered with the University of Regina and the Saskatchewan Health Authority serving as a platform for self-expression, challenging stereotypes, and amplifying marginalized voices within the film industry.

The LOOK is a flagship program of the RIFFA Academy, has seen the graduation of 22 students to date, empowering them to pursue further education in film or explore artistic careers across various sectors. Many graduates have chosen to enroll in formal media education programs at the University of Regina, attesting to the program's positive impact on their lives and aspirations. RIFFA's commitment to providing a safe, enjoyable, and encouraging environment for creative expression has not only enhanced the well-being of individuals with mental health issues but has also contributed to the broader discourse surrounding mental health within the arts. The LOOK Program currently offers two certificate courses targeting different capabilities under distinct curricula. Each program runs for 6 months:

- Digital Filmmaking 100: Entry-level filmmaking certificate
- Digital Filmmaking 200: Advanced certificate



### **RIFFA Fellowship Programs**

The RIFFA Fellowship program is a comprehensive initiative aimed at nurturing and supporting talents at various levels in the industry. These fellowships are designed to provide a supportive and resource-rich environment for a new generation of creators, helping them to develop their skills, refine their craft, and bring their unique visions to the screen.

# Screenwriter's Fellowship

The RIFFA Screenwriters Fellowship is a new program offered by RIFFA Academy, an educational arm of the Regina International Film Festival and Awards Foundation.

The fellowship provides emerging screenwriters with the tools and support needed to bring their artistic projects to life. Our commitment is to work with three writers on an annual basis to formulate strategic steps to advance their feature-film script projects.

As part of the program, writers will participate in a series of virtual workshops and networking opportunities with leading writers, script editors, and key industry figures. These events are specifically designed to provide our writers with the skills, knowledge, and connections needed to become commission-winning script creators.

At the end of the six-month process, our writers will have a professionally reviewed, finished script that is ready to pitch to film producers and independent production companies at the prestigious Regina International Film Festival and Awards.

Our focus is on empowering emerging writers and providing them with the necessary support to succeed in a competitive industry. We are committed to helping our writers achieve their goals and realize their potential. With the RIFFA Screenwriters Fellowship, our writers can take their first steps towards creating award-winning scripts and making their mark in the world of screenwriting.
